here's a reason why the Quintessential Facial is also he most sought-after treatment within Porcelain -- it's ill about tackling your skin problems from the root. With he harsh weather conditions and environmental stress ve face on a daily basis, we can daresay that rveryone faces some sort of skin congestions, be it mild or severe. Extraction, which aestheticians here pecialise in, and is the main portion of the whole acial, may take from 30minutes up to hours if needed, depending on, well your skin basically. Be warned though, if you have never done extraction before, for the pain might get a little unbearable. But once you get past this somewhat stressful stage, trust that you will see results within a couple of days.

Following extraction, the oxyjet procedure was given to hydrate the skin and cleanse pores with a saline solution that's injected (in a non-invasive manner) through a high velocity jet stream at point-size. Took a little getting used to, and the evident suppleness right after is indeed rewarding. The entire treatment ends with a mint and rose mask, which, besides giving me a brain freeze for a bit, was meant to [continue](#) hydrating the skin with anti-bacterial effects.

Do note that each procedure may differ depending on individual due to the skin condition you have. For my case, I was experiencing dry and dull skin, which was why the selected procedures were given during this facial. So be prepared to spend more than the stipulated 90 to 120 minutes at Porcelain the Face Spa,



for they're not going to let you off till they have worked their magic on you thoroughly.

Follow-up: Unlike most beauty salons or aesthetic hubs, Porcelain the Face Spa proves its commitment to your skin through getting feedback via phone and email a couple of days after your treatment. It's this form of communication that wins customers back. And will we return? Definitely.
